

## **Section 2.2: Grants Management Process Summary**

This section provides an overview of the grants management process. The major activities involved in grants management are covered: establishment of grant needs and priorities; opportunity research; opportunity pursuance and vetting; application development and submission; funding decision notification; award set-up; grant implementation; and grant closeout. These roles and responsibilities are discussed in greater detail in subsequent chapters. It is the intent of the Office of Grants and Federal Resources (GFR) that grantors utilize the web-based eCivis grants management tool for end-to-end grant management for the lifecycle of the grant.
