

Section 3.2: Non-Federal Funding Instruments

Non-federal funding sources include other government entities (states, counties, municipalities) as well as private sources, such as foundations or corporate giving programs. The funding opportunities made available vary greatly, as well as the objectives they seek to accomplish. Some of the funding instruments support a broad-based mission (such as health services), while others support a very narrow, well-defined program (such as adult literacy). However, regardless of the types of funding opportunities and organizations awarding those funds to the state, State of Arizona agencies receiving these awards must comply with requirements established by the awarding entity and included in the award agreement. In the case of a governmental entity, this will include applicable statutes and regulations.
