

Section 5.9: Post-Application Submission Activities

Once the grant application is submitted, the work of the grant program manager is mostly done until he/she receives notice that the agency has been awarded a grant--or receives a notice of denial. However, there are times when continued activity is required or recommended. [Section 5.9.1](#) discusses when and what types of communication take place between the grantor and the applicant after the grant application has been submitted.
