

## **Section 2.2: Grants Management Process Summary**

This section provides an overview of the grants management process. The major activities involved in grants management are covered: announcement of funding opportunities; pre-applications; application receipt, review, and award; grants administration; grant monitoring; technical assistance (TA)/problem solving; and grant closeout. These roles and responsibilities are discussed in greater detail in subsequent chapters. It is the intent of the Office of Grants and Federal Resources (GFR) that grantors utilize the web-based eCivis grants management tool for end-to-end grant management for the lifecycle of the grant. Only eCivis or an agency's legacy grants management solution may be utilized for soliciting grants applications or posting notices of funding availability (NOFA). Agencies are not allowed to use procurement systems such as the Arizona Procurement Portal (APP) for grants solicitations.
